JACK In THE BOX 3-on-3 Basketball Tournament

Sat/Sun, May 20-21 – Crown Point Shores, Mission Bay

8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. both days

Over 30 half-courts are set up along the Shores for a weekend of basketball action. There are 20 different divisions for adults and kids of varying skill levels. The festivities include a 3-Point Contest, Free Throw Contest and Slam Dunk Contest on Saturday. Volunteers keep score during games or help with the three-point/free throw contests.

Wienerschnitzel Wiener Nationals

Saturday, September 9 – Rugby Fields at Qualcomm Stadium (near section J-5 in the parking lot)

8:00 a.m. setup and registration, 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. event

Over 300 dachshunds will descend on the Qualcomm Stadium rugby fields and attempt to qualify for the final race, held before the start of the Port of San Diego Big Bay Balloon Parade on December 28. Dogs will be placed in a modified starting gate and will all be timed. The top 10 times advance to the finals. Volunteers register dogs, hand out t-shirts or time races.

Barona \$1 Million Hole-in-One Shootout

Qualifying - Wednesday, September 12-22 – Stadium Golf Center, Mission Valley

10:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. daily.

For 10 days, participants pay \$1 per ball to shoot at a specially designated hole 125-yards away. The golfer whose shot is closest to the pin each day, or anyone who makes a hole-in-one, advances to the final shootout with a chance to win \$1 million. Additionally, prizes are awarded to the 10 closest shots daily. Volunteers register golfers, hand out golf balls or watch the hole for close shots.

Poinsettia Bowl/Holiday Bowl Hospitality Suites

Open between December 15-18 (Poinsettia Bowl) during the evenings at Team Hotels and

open between December 23-27 (Holiday Bowl) during the evenings at Team Hotels.

The Hospitality Suites are where team officials, alumni, and their guests come to socialize, snack and drink during bowl week. There is one suite for each team. Representatives from the Bowl are encouraged to stop by throughout the week. Volunteers work at one of the bars in the suite to serve team officials, alumni, guests and Bowl representatives.

Poinsettia Bowl Pre-Game Show

Tuesday, December 19 – 3 p.m.

The Poinsettia Bowl Pre-Game Show features performances from both college marching bands as well as the Make-a-Wish Foundation Parade of Wishes. Local children from the Make-a-Wish Foundation sing the National Anthem, participate in the coin toss and act as the games' honorary captains. Volunteers hold balloons and participate in the parade on the field.

Port of San Diego Big Bay Balloon Parade

Thursday, December 28 – Harbor Drive, Downtown San Diego

9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

“America’s Largest Balloon Parade” features over 30 massive inflatables, marching bands, floats, specialty units, drill teams, dignitaries and more. Over 100,000 spectators line the streets to watch the procession, which is also televised locally and nationally. Volunteers carry balloons in the parade, assist with costumes or organize entries.
